Toolkit for FY26



The Coalition for Transforming Higher Education Funding is calling on advocates to raise your voice and tell Illinois lawmakers that adequate and equitable funding in Illinois' higher education system is crucial.

Join the Coalition as we advocate for:

- Passing a student-focused, university funding formula to fix the inequities in how Illinois funds its four-year public institutions
 Since 2000, state appropriations to public universities have been cut by 46%. This means that students and their families are increasingly burdened by the cost of higher tuition and fees. Illinois needs a data-driven funding model proposed in these bills that underscores the resources individual universities need to fulfill their missions and ensure their respective student bodies can thrive.
- Prioritizing a \$73 million increase into the Monetary Award Program (MAP) to make college affordable for Illinois students
 A MAP increase of \$73 million will help make college more affordable for MAP eligible students by increasing the total grant amount awarded to eligible applicants. An increase also continues the

trend from the last three years to serve all eligible

Dear [insert state legislator],

As a [share a little about your identity as it relates to higher education e.g. concerned student, parent, educator, citizen of Illinois], I urge you to take bold action to address the deeply embedded equity issues in our higher education system. The Monetary Award Program (MAP) and SB 13/HB 1581 are two critical tools that ensure Illinois can better support our higher education institutions and students.

We know that 60% of Black and 50% of Latinx students disproportionately benefit from MAP funding, increasing college access and affordability. A \$73M MAP investment will ensure that all eligible students can receive the funding to pursue postsecondary education. We must not stop at MAP funding. Declining state appropriations and the lack of an institutional funding model have created an unstable landscape.

Since 2000, state appropriations to public universities have been cut by 46%, burdening students and families with rises in tuition and fees. For too long Illinois has accepted that one university has over \$12,000 to spend per student while another only has \$5,000 per student. This current system is inadequate and inequitable. SB 13/ HB 1581 rightsizes funding, empowering universities to help their students thrive. Higher education opens doors to increased civic engagement, economic growth, and professional opportunities. Our students deserve to access these opportunities without being financially burdened by rising costs. MAP funding and SB 13/HB 1581 have the power to transform the higher education landscape in equitable ways.

We listened to the state budget address on February 19 and while we appreciate the state's commitment to education, we must do more. We will continue to advocate to ensure Illinois leaders will invest in MAP and pass SB 13/ HB 1581. Thank you for working to ensure that our students and universities have the resources needed to succeed.
