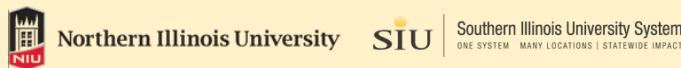

Passing the Adequate and Equitable Public University Funding Act (SB 13/HB 1581)

Illinois students are carrying the burden of a 46% drop in state funding for our public 4-years that has driven tuition up, forced students out, and prompted program cuts that have impacted not just students, but our communities, and Illinois' overall sustainability. SB 13/HB 1581 will fix this by creating a fair, student-focused funding formula for public universities.



Approving \$71 million for the Monetary Award Program (MAP)

Last year, many eligible students lost their MAP awards when funds ran out, forcing them to make difficult decisions. For decades, MAP has made earning a college degree more affordable for thousands of Illinois students. A \$71 million increase would restore grants for eligible students who have went without, and make college truly accessible for every student who qualifies.
